## KINGDOM SECURITIES

#### **Daily Market Wrap**

- Market Indicators: Equities had a mixed performance as NASI flattened +(0.02%) at 178.08 as NSE20 rose 0.48% to 2973.85. NSE10 and NSE25 eased 0.35% and 0.22% to 1751.95 and 4546.06, respectively. Market cap held steady at Kes. 2805.65Bn, with volumes up 4.95% to 66.76Mn shares and equities turnover up 3.42% to Kes. 1785.64Mn.
- **Top Gainers/Losers:** Express Kenya (+9.67%), Home Afrika (+7.83%), and Flame Tree (+6.67%) led gainers, while E.A. Portland Cement (-7.36%), KCB (-6.05%), and Kenya Re (-4.42%) topped losers.
- **Top Movers:** Safaricom (Kes. 1.04Bn) dominated activity, followed by KCB (Kes. 305.92Mn), Equity (Kes. 79.57Mn), DTB (Kes. 65.26Mn), and EABL (Kes. 62.92Mn).
- Foreigners' Participation: Safaricom led trading with heavy net outflows at Kes. -476.84Mn, overshadowing its buys of Kes. 400.93Mn. On the inflow side, EABL (Kes. 29.58Mn), DTB (Kes. 9.18Mn), and Equity (Kes. 7.35Mn) posted gains, supported by modest entries in BAT (Kes. 5.51Mn) and KenGen (Kes. 0.51Mn). Outflows also hit Jubilee (Kes. -4.50Mn), Kenya Re (Kes. -2.21Mn), Kenya Airways (Kes. -2.18Mn), and I&M (Kes. -1.39Mn), signaling continued pressure on Safaricom and select banking counters, partially offset by buying interest in beverage and banking stocks.
- Bonds Market: Secondary bond turnover fell 22.61% to Kes. 7.32Bn from Kes. 9.46Bn in the previous session, with activity led by IFB1/2018/15Yr (Kes. 1.00Bn), IFB1/2022/19Yr (Kes. 897.00Mn), and FXD1/2013/15Yr (Kes. 315.00Mn).
- Market Update: Retail investors, including individuals, companies, and self-help groups, have poured a record Kes. 1.44Trn into unit trusts and government bonds, more than doubling from Kes. 0.58Trn in 2023. The shift reflects rising business costs, reduced consumer spending, and economic uncertainty, with collective investment participants reaching 2.46Mn by mid-2025. High demand was fueled by the August 2025 reopening of two infrastructure bonds, raising Kes. 274.80Bn. Slower growth in agriculture and manufacturing, alongside risky traditional ventures, has driven investors toward low-risk government securities, doubling domestic debt from Kes. 404.50Bn to Kes. 844.30Bn between 2023 and 2025.
